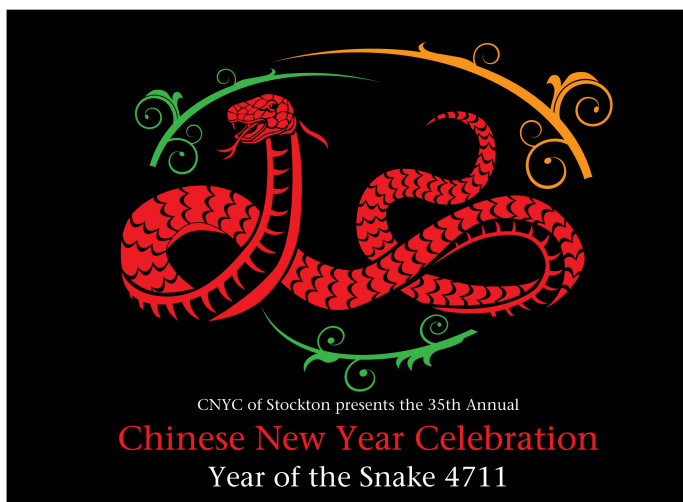

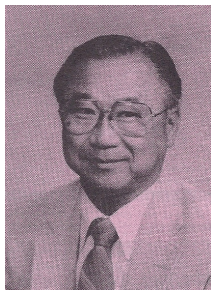

In Memoriam

Keith Wong



Keith Wong was instrumental in the formation of the Chinese Cultural Society of Stockton and was a past president. Keith's long commitment to community service reaches back to the old Chinese Christian Center and St. Mark's Methodist Church. He was a member of the Youth Club and later, one of its counselors. He was involved in Sunday school

and community projects among the Chinese. As an early member and past president of the Cathay Club, Keith was involved in all facets of its activities. Keith also helped to form the Chinese Historical Committee whose purpose was to "preserve and promote the heritage and history of Chinese in the Stockton area," serving alternately as chairman and editor of the quarterly newsletter. He helped spearhead the Old Stockton Chinatown Historical Monument Committee, with the aim towards building a monument at the southeast corner of Washington and El Dorado Streets, to mark the site of the old Chinatown block.

A memorial service will be held at a later date. As of this publication date, no details were available.
