## CCSS Scholarships

Know a high school student or Delta College student who needs a scholarship? A scholarship program administered by CCSS, which includes up to ten merit-based awards, are given to graduating high school seniors and a San Joaquin Delta student each year. Students must be of Chinese descent, write an essay, submit a grade transcript and letters of recommendation along with a completed application to be eligible for any of the awards. Scholarship information will be available beginning in December/January from counselors at each local high school within the San Joaquin County. Awards will be presented at the CCSS annual Spring Banquet in April.
