

# **CCSS Scholarships**

Students must be of Chinese descent, write an essay, submit a grade transcript and letters of recommendation along with a completed application to be eligible for any of the awards. Scholarship information will be available beginning in December/January from counselors at each local high school within the San Joaquin County. Awards will be presented at the CCSS annual Spring Banquet in April.
