Chinese Benevolent Association of Stockton Offers Third Annual Chinese Culture Camp This Summer

The halls of the historic Confucius Church of Stockton will ring with sounds of excited voices once again this summer, as children entering grades 1-6 absorb the sounds, tastes, and beauty of the Chinese culture. Returning activities included abacus instruction and mental math, a variety of Chinese crafts, and vocal and recorder music. This year the always-exciting Lion Dance class will feature a *pride* of lions, as the camp now has *five* lion heads, affording a greater opportunity for individual participation! Folk dancers will learn to use new accessories. Calligraphy and brush painting instruction has been lengthened. Children will learn new recipes, expanding their repertoire of easy-to-make Chinese delicacies. Quiet activities are balanced by physical activities. This year Tai Chi for Children will be added to the traditional children's games of free spinning yo-yos and elastic jump roping.

The camp has increased by one day each of the past two years for the same low price. This summer there will be five full mornings of instruction, followed by a Saturday Open House with performances, display of projects, refreshments and an opportunity to learn about the Mandarin School and craft classes offered during the regular school year at the same location. The camp takes place June 24-29, 2013, from 8:30 a.m.—12:30 p.m. For working parents, arrangements can be made for additional afternoon enrichment activities for an hourly fee.
